FEES

Membership fees are invoiced and to be paid annually before the last day of February each year. Fees are payable immediately on receipt of invoice.

In accordance with the SAIBPP Memorandum of Incorporation, membership fees are subject to increase/adjustment each year as determined by the SAIBPP Board of Directors. In the case of resignation, cancellation or lapsed membership, a re-registration fee of R1500 will be charged over and above the annual membership fee.

Membership fees are divided into three categories:

INDIVIDUAL: R1500 p/a

STUDENT: R200 p/a*

*Student membership is only applicable to full time students who are currently enrolled in a recognised academic institution in a full time academic programme. Students enrolled in part time programmes are ineligible for Student Membership. Proof of enrolment will be required.

CORPORATE MEMBERSHIP

Corporate members are permitted to register for any category of membership. The membership categories include: Platinum, Gold, Silver membership.

Only registered employees within a member company may benefit from SAIBPP corporate membership. Member companies will be required to supply details of all employees who are to be registered under their corporate membership within 7-days of paying membership invoice. It is the responsibility of each corporate member to inform the SAIBPP secretariat of any changes in employee membership.
